



Professor T. Nejat Veziroglu Endorses Harry Braun for President

Professor T. Nejat Veziroglu, who is President of the International Association for Hydrogen Energy (iahe.org) and Editor in Chief of its *International Journal of Hydrogen Energy*, has endorsed Harry Braun for President. The IAHE, which is similar to the Society of Automotive Engineers, was founded by Dr. Veziroglu and other distinguished scientists and engineers over 30 years ago, and the organization is now an international peer-review technical society that has hundreds of chemists and engineers as members from over 80 countries.

For the past 30 years, Dr. Veziroglu has been a professor of mechanical engineering at the University of Miami and serves as its Director of the university's Clean Energy Research Institute. He has known Harry Braun since 1979, and after reviewing his Phoenix Project book and related hydrogen research, he invited Mr. Braun to become an Advisory Board Member of the IAHE in 1981. Dr. Veziroglu is all too aware that the energy and environmental problems are global in nature, and as such, he has endorsed Harry Braun's campaign for President in the hope that American voters will empower Harry to have America lead the world into a solar hydrogen economy that will provide sustainable global prosperity without pollution.

The Phoenix Project

America spends approximately \$1 trillion annually on energy. As such, oil and utility companies will then employ millions of Americans and invest in the mass-production of Windships, ocean thermal energy conversion (OTEC) and other renewable hydrogen production technologies. Even the largest oil or coal resource will eventually be depleted, but the solar hydrogen energy system is completely renewable, which means it will also be providing a “renewable rate of return” on the investment.

The large-scale deployment of Windships and OTEC plants will make America energy independent while simultaneously resolving the most serious environmental problems, including providing a critical sanctuary for the fish and other marine organisms that are now in the final stages of being driven into extinction by oil and chemical pollution and unregulated destructive fishing practices.

American voters now have the opportunity to elect a President who will initiate a “transition of substance” that will fundamentally resolve America’s economic, environmental and foreign policy problems. The only question is whether the news media will look beyond the two major political parties and inform the American public about Harry and his Phoenix Project Platform.
